Parents committee urges pressure on fate of missing

The Parents Committee for the Kidnapped and Missing in Lebanon said on Wednesday that it was the government's responsibility to follow up on the issue of missing people, whoever they are and wherever they were.

A statement said that the committee called on the government to release the report by the Committee for Complaints immediately, for it contained a preliminary solution regarding missing people.

The committee was satisfied with Hizbullah's secretary-general Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah's talk about negotiations with Israel about the fate of missing Lebanese and Palestinians during Israel's invasion of Lebanon in 1982, the statement added.

It also said with the formation of a new Syrian government, which announced its reform program, the committee urged the Lebanese Cabinet to consider the file of the missing and detainees in Syria seriously.
