As a member of Amnesty International (AI), I am trying to find out what has happened to the following persons and where they are:

SHAWQI 'ALI JAMUL, Shi'ite Muslim, born 1954  
HASSAN MUHAMMAD ZAHWI, Muslim, born 1951  
'ISSAM 'ALI AL-MASRI, Sunni Muslim, born 1964  
MOHIE ED-DIN HASHISHO, The Communist Party, born 1927  
MUHAMMAD MAHMOUD MANSOUR, born 1955  
SAMIA MUHAMMAD AL-MAHMOUD, Muslim, born 1958  
MUHAMMAD ABU ZEID, Muslim, born 1943  
HAMZA MUHAMMAD ABU ZEID, Muslim, born 1965  
TAYSSIR MUHAMMAD ABU ZEID, Muslim, born 1964  
MASSER MUHAMMAD ABU ZEID, Muslim, born 1967

AI is concerned for the safety of these ten individuals who "disappeared" between September 1982 and August 1983.

AI is opposed to the "disappearance" of prisoners in all cases, irrespective of the reasons for their arrest. AI seeks an immediate end to all "disappearances". AI states that a "disappearance" has occurred when a person is arrested, detained or abducted against his or her will or otherwise deprived of his or her liberty.

I strongly support your efforts to urge the Lebanese Government to set up a commission of inquiry to establish the fate of the "disappeared". I also support your work to determine the appropriateness of the compensation for the victims and their families. In this connection, please find enclosed a copy of the letter I have sent to the Government authorities.

Please keep me updated on this issue if you happen to know anything about the above mentioned individuals.
