Dear Mrs Halwani,


I am a teacher of Religious Education in a Secondary School in the United Kingdom and, being a member of Amnesty International Teachers and Academic Network, came to hear about the distressing story of your husband's disappearance whilst conducting humanitarian activities during the invasion of the Lebanon by the Israelis in 1982.

We can but scarcely imagine what you have gone through in terms of personal anguish, fear and worry compounded by the reluctance of the authorities to establish and account for the fate of your husband and, I understand, many other people on whose behalf you have been courageously campaigning.

I have written to the President, Prime Minister and Minister of Justice expressing my concerns and asking them to do all in their power to establish the whereabouts or fate of your husband and to take what steps they can to ensure that those responsible for any miscarriage of justice are brought to justice.

The tenacity, fortitude and resolution of yourself and your supporters sets an example for all who have justice at heart.
