Besides the fact; That none of the illegal parties has the right to capture others' freedom, especially if they were innocent. this matter opposes the most simple human rights which is the right to live.

this tragedy of human kidnapping, doesnot stop on kidnapped persons only. but it reaches hundreds of families by surrounding our neck with a sword made of oppression and agony and the need for materialistic and moral motivation.

This tragedy destroys us , because kidnapping is most severe than killing .

MR. PRESIDENT

we had tried many times with our responsible people in the concerned official authority; especially with our president to put

an end to this tragedy , however , up till now , we have not gained anything , except promises .

Thus , starting from our tragedy , and your concern on defending human rights and your active and effective role in our problems in Lebanon , and also the force which you could apply on the concerned parties , we are waiting an action , especially when we came to learn of your being able to release the hostages and besieged people at the city of DIER - AL QAMAR .

We are certain that you will not disappoint mothers, sisters and children, whom in the name of mercy and humanity, hope to see you freeing their beloved fathers, brothers, and sons.
