OBJET - SUBJECT : Missing Persons - Lebanon

- 1. Mr. Sinan Al Barraje, Lebanese Lawyer, representing the Committee of Relatives of Detained, Disappeared and Abducted Persons in Lebanon will be in Geneva on 28 June 1984 and has requested a meeting with you. He has indicated that he will be available on the afternoon of the 28th or in the morning of the 29th.
- 2. Mr. Al Barraje has indicated that the purpose of his visit is the continuing problem of violations of Human Rights in Lebanon, particularly that of disappeared persons.
- 3. Mr. Al Barraje will be accompanied by Mrs. Wadad Halwani, wife of a disappeared lebanese teacher and member of the Committee. She met with the Working Group on Enforced or Involuntary Disappearances during its 11th session in September 1983.
- 4. Both Mr. Barraje and Mrs. Halwani live in Lebanon and are in Paris to attend a conference on missing persons in Lebanon organized by "La Federation Internationale des droits de l'homme". They were able to leave Lebanon only with a great deal of difficulties.
