

MUHAMMAD ABU ZEID, Muslim, born 1943
HAMZA MUHAMMAD ABU ZEID, Muslim, born 1965
TAYSSIR MUHAMMAD ABU ZEID, Muslim, born 1964
MASSER MUHAMMAD ABU ZEID, Muslim, born 1967

AI is concerned for the safety of these ten individuals who "disappeared" between September 1982 and August 1983.

AI is an worldwide human rights organisation which works to promote all the human rights enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and other international standards.

AI is opposed to the "disapperance" of prisoners in all cases, irrespective of the reasons for their arrest, and seeks an immediate end to all "disappearances". AI states that a "disappearance" has occured when a person is arrested, detained or abducted against his or her will proof otherwise deprived of his or her liberty.

I urge you to set up an independent commission of inquiry to investigate the fate of the "disappeared". To help you in this work, please find enclosed AI's criteria for such a commission
