We will do our utmost to ascertain 'Adnan's whereabouts, bring those responsible to justice and ensure that the occurrence of 'disappearances' ends in Lebanon. The most important thing we will do is to make sure that 'Adnan's case is never forgotten.

I can't even begin to imagine how difficult the last 16 years must have been for you and your family. I can only hope that the knowledge that people all over the world are working on behalf of your husband will give you strength and comfort.

Take heart and remember that you are not alone.
